It is designed to meet the needs of those moving into supervisory positions or for those who need to review supervisory principles.

Seventeen employers representing Richland, Ashland, and Crawford counties took advantage of the new Introduction to Supervision training provided by North Central State College. Currently 182 employees have completed the training. Topics offered in two hour blocks include: Leadership and Supervision, Communication, Team Building, Conflict and Confrontation, Problem Solving, Coaching, Feedback, Change, Time Management and Delegation, Lean, and Blueprint. This training is partially funded by the \$2.9 million dollar TAACCCT grant awarded by the DOL to fund advanced manufacturing.
